Dear Most Honourable Mr. John Howard,

I greet you in the name of Jesus, Our Lord.

Some months ago you were kind enough to answer my letter with a personal response regarding the matter of Iraq — I thank you for that.

Now, I need to come to you about another issue of importance regarding myself and the work I am involved with.

The reason I write to you is first, to advise you that I have approached the High Commissioner for Human Rights at the United Nations. The purpose of my letter to you is to assure you that I have no intentions of embarrassing you or the Australian Government — however, Mr. Howard, I am left with no alternative — as my human rights have been violated in an enormous way since my work began in 1984. This, mostly by the Roman Catholic Church and the Australian Press and Media; not to mention the Local Council and authorities.

I have also written to The Honourable Simon Crean, MP to advise him of this same issue.


I have been a public figure since 1984 — known throughout the world. However, many powerful Bodies around Australia — even the World — have worked to bring me ill-repute.

Last year — August 8, 2002 I was arrested and charged for offences I did not commit. There was collusion and obstruction of Justice relating to my Court Case and other Court matters which my Legal Advisors are currently dealing with. I know Mr. Howard, you are a very busy man and would not have time to study every man's complaint — however, I would ask that you read my Website to see my plight.

The Religious Order that I founded in 1986 has grown to 160 Countries and has some 500,000 members.

I desire only to be able to practice our beliefs and have true Justice served.
